CCFS offers over 20 comprehensive and diverse programs to assist families in overcoming challenges, making responsible choices, and improving quality of life for its constituents. In addition to its headquarters in Hampton, CCFS has an office here in Williamsburg.

More than 30 employees support two primary specialties of the center — consumer credit counseling and behavioral health services. The consumer credit counseling service program has certified credit counselors who work with families to develop realistic plans to reach their financial goals.

The behavioral health services program provides comprehensive trauma-informed counseling services to children, adults, families, and organizations and has been designed to help people face the problems of daily life and find solutions to those problems. The goal is to improve the quality of life for each individual or family.

Other services provided include adult anger management, counseling services, domestic violence batterer intervention services, servicios en Español, substance abuse services, neurofeedback, and more.

The center is run by a well-seasoned professional staff, with extensive knowledge of behavioral health, financial counseling, and management operations. Ford's Colony resident Casey Duplantier, the retired CEO of 1st Advantage Federal Credit Union, is a long-standing member of the CCFS board. "I can't begin to tell you how lucky we are to have Casey on our side," says Bryan. "His knowledge of the market and recognition of our relevancy has been a tremendous asset to the center and my fellow board members."

"With the pandemic hitting our economy so hard, the underserved in the local area have really struggled. Fortunately, we're well-positioned to lend a hand and have the support of many local businesses and financial institutions."

Are there volunteer opportunities if someone wants to help?

"There are many events the center sponsors, including the annual Country For Kids Concert and the Holiday Light Stroll held in Newport News Park.
